



Dear parents/ carers,


As an incentive for your child to read, develop a love of reading and engage with a wider range of texts, we are using reward badges in KS2.


Your child will be able to choose which ones to work towards and how many they would like to do throughout the rest of the year. The badges are to be completed at home. The badges will be displayed in the learning hub for the children to collect. Each badge completed will equate to 1 ticket. Tickets will be signed by the class teacher upon completion of the badge and will be submitted into a prize draw. At the end of each half term 1 ticket will be selected from the prize draw to win a book gift card.

I would encourage your child to try to earn as many different badges as they can but they may choose to do the same badge more than once- that's fine too! I hope you will encourage your child to read for at least 10 minutes every day and please sign their reading record to say what they have read, for how many minutes or how many pages. In this booklet there is a description of what challenge the children will need to complete to earn each badge so please keep it with your reading journal.

	<p>Roald Dahl Finish reading any book by Roald Dahl. Draw your favourite character and then describe them in a paragraph.</p>		<p>Movie Buff Finish a book that has been made into a film. Write a paragraph to compare them and explain which one you prefer and why?</p>
	<p>Spooky Finish reading a scary story and describe the scariest part in as much detail as you can. Can you scare?</p>		<p>Fantasy Finish reading a myth or fantasy book. Draw and describe one of the mythical creatures in a paragraph.</p>

	<p>Poetry Read a poetry book and learn a poem to recite off by heart and share with the class.</p>		<p>Long Read Finish reading a book which is over 100 pages long.</p>
	<p>Dictionary Clarify 10 new words from your reading book using a dictionary. Put the words into your own sentences.</p>		<p>Fairy Tale Read a fairy tale and then draw a story map to show what happens in the beginning, build up, problem and ending.</p>
	<p>Adventurer Finish a sci-fi or adventure story. Write a character description.</p>		<p>Animal Lover Read a book about animals. Draw and describe your favourite character in a paragraph.</p>
	<p>Sporty Finish reading a book about a sport that you are interested in. Write about three new things that you learned.</p>		<p>Author Write your own version of a book you have read! Change the topic, characters, setting or the ending! Be creative.</p>
	<p>Traveller Read a book that is set in a different place, country, world or planet! Draw and write a paragraph to describe the setting.</p>		<p>French Read one of the French books from the library. Write down five new words that you have learned and their translation.</p>
	<p>Bible Read a story from the bible and write what you think the meaning of the story was.</p>		<p>Letter Writer Write a letter to an author explaining why you enjoyed their book and ask them some questions!</p>
